CHAIRMAN'S ADDRESS

Emcee, SSGT Priya announced that the necessary quorum for the Annual General Meeting (AGM) was attained. The meeting was called to order at 10:30 hrs.

2 Thereafter, Emcee requested members to refer to the booklet for the agenda before inviting the Chairman of Training Command Unit Welfare Fund (TUWF) Management Committee to deliver the keynote address.

3 Chairman welcomed members to the AGM of TUWF. He then proceeded to address the meeting.

4 Chairman shared that the AGM provided a good platform for:

- a Members to be briefed on the activities that had been organised for the members between 1 July 2017 and 31 July 2018; and
- b Members to show their appreciation to the Management Committee for their continuous effort.

5 Chairman then went on to brief the members on some of the activities conducted. They included:

- TRACOM Appreciation Dinner;
- TRACOM Unit Bonding to Universal Studios Singapore (USS);
- TRACOM Healthy Lifestyle Event Island Hopping Cruise;
- TRACOM Fruit Fiesta; and
- TRACOM Appreciation Lunch.

6 He commended the Management Committee for organising these events successfully and noted that the activities were well received by the members.

7 The Management Committee also constantly searching for avenues to improve the welfare of our staff. Corporate memberships of various places of interest in Singapore are reviewed regularly and renewed or replaced, based on take-up rates and suggestions from the Committee. The corporate pass for the Wildlife Reserve Singapore which allows admission to Zoological Garden and River Safari was renewed. Jurong Bird Park Corporate Pass was replaced with Mega Adventure Park corporate pass providing trilling activities for patrons to enjoy.

8 The Management Committee would continue to look into new and exciting ways to enhance the welfare and well-being.

Societal Responsibility

9 While members continued to benefit from these activities, Chairman was pleased to note that the less fortunate was not forgotten. As part of societal responsibilities, TRACOM staff continued to provide support to the Share-A-Meal 2018 project by facilitating in the labeling, distribution and counting of 470 donation

tins. The project collected a total of \$43,000. Chairman was sure that the efforts meant a lot to those in need.

10 Before ending his speech, Chairman took the opportunity to thank the members of the Management Committee 2017/2018 for hard work and contribution towards the welfare needs. Chairman also expressed his gratitude to those who may have directly or indirectly contributed to the well-being of our members.

11 Chairman concluded by reminding all members that welfare activities should be organised based on what the members wanted and must benefit the majority of staff and trainees of TRACOM.

Societal Responsibilities (SR) Sub-Committee

Blood Donation Drive

9 The Societal Responsibilities Sub-Committee organised two blood donation drives on 14 December 2018 & 05 July 2019. This was a joint initiative with Singapore Red Cross to promote awareness on blood donation to reach out to young donors. It garnered 233 successful donors in both events.

Salvation Army Donation Drive

10 This joint initiative with Salvation Army aimed to encourage recycling and helping the needy. The drive was held between 25th and 31st January 2019 where staff could donate their pre-loved items comprising clothes, shoes, books stationary, toys and small electrical appliances at a worktainer (a large container to house the items) at Block 11. The drive was also supported units from HTA, TCDD and HTSCI. The SR Sub-Committee managed to successfully collect six worktainers full of donations for the needy.

S.A.M Coin Counting Day

11 For the past 10 over years, TRACOM had been supporting the Compassion Fund Ltd. The Compassion Fund Ltd, a charitable organisation, that aimed to raise funds annually in order to help students whose families are in crisis due to the sudden death of the families' breadwinner. Staff continued to provide support to the Share-A-Meal 2019 project by facilitating in the labeling, distribution of the donation tins.

12 On 16 April 2019, volunteers from TRACOM, HTSCI and TCDD come together with volunteers from Beyond Social Services and Compassion Fund Ltd, had gathered at HTA Fine Dining Hall to collate the donations from the Share-A-Meal. At the end of the event, the project collected a total of more than \$90,000 raised for the needy.

Healthy Life-style Sub-Committee

Kick-Boxing Sessions

13 To promote healthy living and team-bonding among staff, the Healthy Life-style Sub-committee has organised four kickboxing sessions on Thursdays graced by Vice-Chairperson and CO BTS in the month of January and February 2019. During the talk, staff were briefed on prevention on bad workplace ergonomics. 15 The TRACOM/TCDD/HTSCI Family Day was held at Resort World Sentosa, Adventure Cove on 27 October 2018. Gracing the event was Vice-Chairperson who gave an opening speech before the staff, family and friends entered the attraction for a fun-filled range of activities. To commemorate this occasion, each officer received a customised memo bottle and food vouchers to patronise inside Adventure Cove. The event saw an encouraging response as 80% of the staff attended the event.

Appreciation Dinner 2019

16 TRACOM Appreciation Dinner was successfully held on 22 February 2019 at Marriott Tang Plaza Hotel. This year's theme, Mafia Night, was attended by 450 officers and guests who enjoyed the sumptuous food and great performances. DC (Ops) was also invited as the Guest-of-Honour to grace this special event.

17 The event started with great dance performance put up by the Appreciation Dinner Committee to welcome GOH and Commander TRACOM. This was followed by a speech by Commander TRACOM expressing his appreciation to all staff for their commitment and contribution for the past year. Next, there was a line-up of performances put up by the performance artists, entertaining games hosted by our emcees and many attractive prizes won by our staff.

Trainees Bonding Day

18 The inaugural Trainees Bonding Day, held on 31 August 2018, saw trainees across different squads and vocations grouped into six different houses, representing C.L.I.F; the four core values of the SPF.
